SPECIFICATIONS

Yacht will be equipped with one cedar row boat 10 feet in length, complete with all fittings.

Composite, Cutter Rigged, Racing Yacht for 51 ft. Class.

Attached to Contract Dated Jan 8. 1900. for Mr Cord Meyer Shop No 539.

Length over all, - - - - - about 73 feet.

Length on water line, - - - - - about 45 feet.

Beam, - - - - - about 14 feet.

Draft of water, - - - - - about 10' 3".

All, or nearly all, ballast to be on the outside and of Lead cast to form.

All framing to be of Steel: The stem, sternpost and keel, to be of best white oak.

All fastening below deck frame to be of bronze and copper.

Planking to be of yellow pine; to be double from below the turn of bilge to sheer strake, the inner thickness to be cypress.

Deck to be selected white pine and is to have the seams filled with marine glue.

There will be a low bulwark capped with a mahogany rail.

All hatches, hatch coamings and skylights, are to be of mahogany or butternut.

Yacht to be steered with a tiller.

There will be a binnacle, fitted with a liquid compass, of standard make.

The cabin wood work is to be of butternut with mahogany trimmings, and the cabin and state room, are to be furnished with sahite

The saloon will be fitted with two settees.

Aft of same will be the companionway with toilet room to star- board, clothes lockers, and to port a settee, and state room aft of same fitted with berths.
