

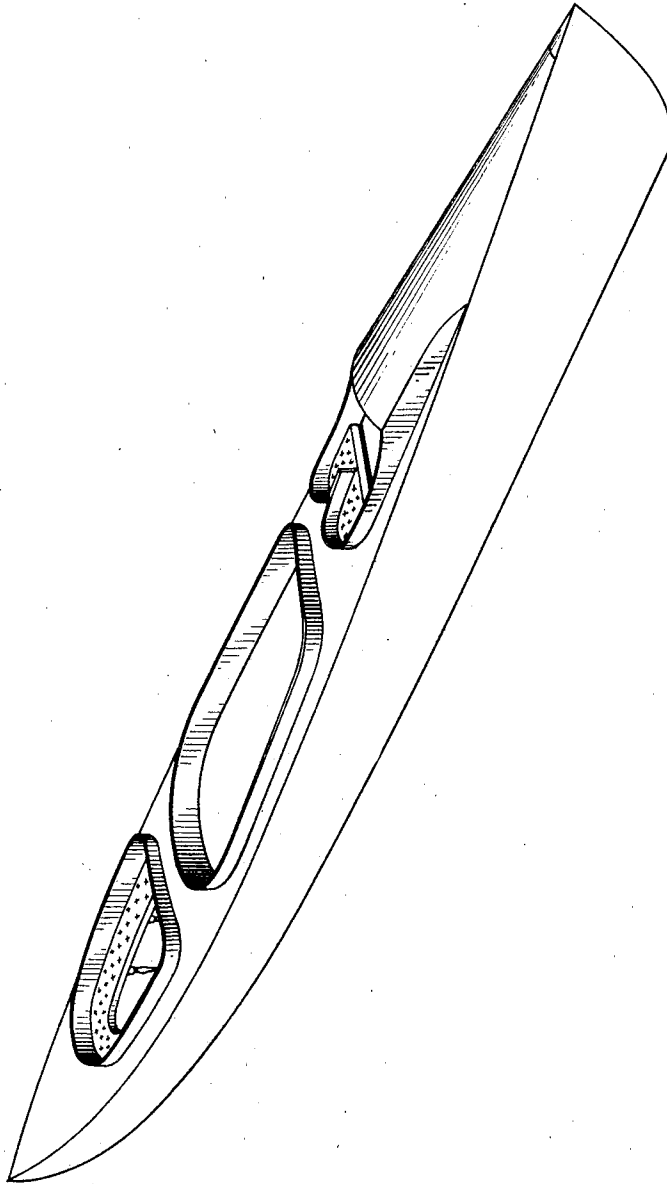

DESIGN FOR A POWER-BOAT.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 37,252, dated November 29, 1904.

Application filed March 24, 1904. Serial No. 199,875. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:
